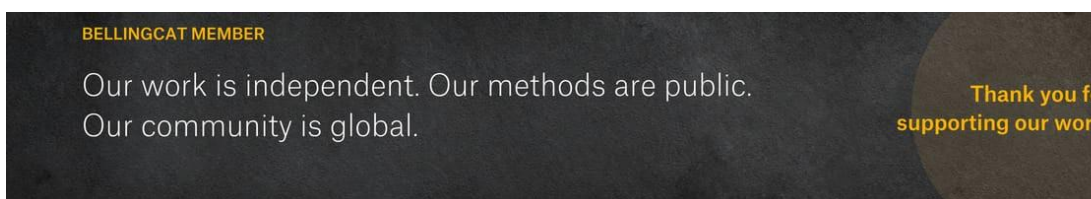


Bellingcat's in-person workshops opening

Bellingcat Investigations – like those that uncover the people behind nudification websites or identify wildlife traffickers on social media – may span months, if not years, and involve thousands of snippets of information and the use of varied open source research techniques.
